School Pictures:

Can You Donate?

St. Joseph School will be holding a Blood Drive on Thursday, September 28th from 2:00-6:00p.m. in the school gym. If we have 20 donors, our school will receive \$250 in grant money to use for our students. We use the money that we receive from the blood drives to help with the cost of a bus to attend different field trips.

Catechetical Sunday:

On Sunday, September 17th we will celebrate Catechetical Sunday at St. Joseph Parish. This is where we recognize everyone who is helping to bring Catholic education to our students. We will begin with Mass at 8:30 a.m., followed by a gathering in the school. The PEC will be serving doughnuts and juice in the cafeteria after Mass.

Scrip:

We have a Scrip program at St. Joseph School. Both HG-IC and St. Rose who are in our pastorate have one also. The Scrip program is where you can by gift cards to spend at grocery stores, restaurants, etc., and then St. Joseph School receives a percentage from the cards you purchase. I challenge every family in our school to try our Scrip program. Even if you use them for one item such as gas or groceries, it will help our school. The Scrip program made a profit of \$665.07 for the month of August.
